



COPPER SINKS

Copper is a relatively soft, malleable metal that is easily molded. However, minor dents can occur during shipping or installation. A sink may become inverted slightly at its bottom, creating what is known as a "high spot."

To correct a high spot or minor dent, apply pressure using the heel of the hand or lightly tapping the area with a rubber mallet. A bent rim may be corrected by placing the sink upside down on a solid, level surface and gently tapping with the mallet. Rest assured that steps taken to remove a dent in a copper sink will not void its warranty.
