



## DRAWER REMOVAL FOR CABINETS WITH CONCEALED GLIDES

### TOOLS NEEDED:



1. Locate the two screws on the underside of the drawer that you wish to remove. There is one screw on each side of the drawer, as indicated in **Figure A**.

2. Using a Phillip's screwdriver, remove each of the screws (**Figure B**). Remove with caution, as the screws are small and can easily be lost. Set aside in a safe place once removed.

3. There is a small pin directly behind each screw hole, which holds the drawer in place. Slightly raise the front of the drawer off of the pins, then carefully pull the drawer out from the cabinet (**Figure C**). The glides will remain in place.

4. When ready, replace the drawer in the reverse order in which it was removed.
